Eikos also offers a 12 x 2 Scaled Native Matrix with true seamless switching. In this mode, up to 2 PIPs can be added on a still background and a mirror function is available.

In QuadraVision mode, **Eikos** allows the display of 4 computer or video sources on the main output. A Video Output card provides SD or HDTV formats in various signals from Composite Video to HD SDI.

Fully controlled from its own front panel as well as from its Remote Control Software (supplied) or from the new **Axion2**, the **Orchestra** and the **RK-300** and **TRK-800** Remote Consoles, **Eikos** offers a large range of utilization. **Eikos** also comes in a Light Edition, **Eikos LE** (Ref.
